

MASNŪN IFŢĀR DU^cĀS¹

Supplicating at the time of Iftar is sunnah. The Prophet \circledast said, "Indeed, the fasting person has at the time of breaking the fast a supplication which is not rejected" (*Sunan Ibn Mājah*, 1753).

Imām Nawawī (d. 676/1277) has narrated in *al-Adhkār* the following four du^cās from the Prophet \implies at the time of breaking the fast:

ذَهَبَ الظَّمَأُ وَابْتَلَّتِ الْعُرُوْقُ وَثَبَتَ الْأَجْرُ إِنْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ

(1) The thirst has gone, the veins are moistened, and the reward is established, if Allah wills.

ٱللَّهُمَّ لَكَ صُمْتُ وَعَلَى رِزْقِكَ أَفْطَرْتُ

(2) O Allah, I fasted for You, and with Your sustenance I completed my fast.

اَلْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِيْ أَعَانَنِيْ فَصُمْتُ وَرَزَقَنِيْ فَأَفْطَرْتُ

(3) All praise is due to Allah who assisted me, so I fasted and who provided me, so I could complete my fast.

ٱللَّهُمَّ لَكَ صُمْنا وَعَلَى رِزْقِكَ أَفْطَرْنَا فَتَقَبَّلْ مِنَّا إِنَّكَ أَنْتَ السَّمِيْعُ العَلِيْمُ

(4) O Allah, for You we fast, and by Your provision, we complete our fast. So accept from us. You are indeed the All-Hearing, the All-Knowing.

Imām Nawawī relates a fifth duʿā' which ʿAbd Allah ibn ʿAmr 🚓 would read:

اَللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ بِرَحْمَتِكَ الَّتِيْ وَسِعَتْ كُلَّ شَيْءٍ أَنْ تَغْفِرَ لِيْ

(5) O Allah, I ask You by Your mercy which envelops all things, that You forgive me.

Imām Nawawī relates a **sixth du^cā**² to be read when invited to complete the fast with others:

أَفْطَرَ عِنْدَكُمُ الصَّائِمُوْنَ وَأَكَلَ طَعَامَكُمُ الْأَبْرَارُ وَصَلَّتْ عَلَيْكُمُ المَلاَئِكَة

(6) May fasting people continue to complete their fast with you, may the pious eat your food, and may the angels bless you.

It is worth noting that these duʿās are to be read **after** completing the fast. Prior to breaking the fast, one should read بسم الله. The fifth duʿāʾ read by ʿAbd Allah ibn ʿAmr الله can be read before or after Ifṭār. In addition, one should supplicate to Almighty Allah with other duʿās before Ifṭār and throughout the fast as the duʿās of a fasting person are accepted.
